

# News from Roxborough Village Metropolitan District



On December 9<sup>th</sup>, over fifty members of the community joined the Board of Directors and the skate park design team to discuss the design and schedule for the Roxborough Skate Park. The design is nearly complete, and construction is expected to start in spring 2009 and be complete mid-summer. The design includes bike- and skate-friendly bowls, a “street” area, a shade shelter, benches, and a path to connect users to the parking lots on the north and south ends of the Community Park. The skate park will not have lights, and will be open access and self-monitored. This means that park users will be encouraged to use peer pressure to keep the park safe, clean, and enjoyable. The attending community members were very excited and supportive. Please visit the District’s website for more information and to see computer models of the park.

The District’s landscape contractor, The Brickman Group, continues to be responsible for snow removal along the District’s walks and trails. Typically, the trails are plowed when snow accumulation exceeds 2”. Ice-melt is used only on the most ice-prone areas. Every attempt will be made to clear the walks and trails before 8:00 AM.
